DIRECTIONS: Auditions will be held in the Dance Room, located in the House of Charm, in Balboa Park. It is the building located in Alcazar Garden. The park offers free parking in both the Alcazar Parking lot, as well as the large lot behind the Organ Pavilion. I suggest that you come early, as parking can sometimes be a challenge. Once you arrive at the House of Charm a door monitor will let you in, and guide you to our check-in area.
